

13 foreigners held over use of apartments as brothels

KUALA LUMPUR: Thirteen foreigners were detained for allegedly using low-cost apartments as brothels in two raids in Jalan Pudu here on Wednesday. Immigration Department director-general Datuk Khairul Dzaimie Daud said 27 immigration officers raided both premises at 3.30pm.

“During the raid, we detained a guard who brought us to the premises.

There were attempts by a foreign woman and a client to escape, but they failed as all exits had been cordoned off. Thirteen foreigners, aged between 20 and 40, including eight women from Vietnam, four women from Indonesia and a man from Vietnam, were detained. Two Malaysian men, who were the doormen, and six local customers were issued with notices to provide statements.”
